I am extremely appreciative but not sure I deserve it as, by the grace of God, I have just done my job, which I love, and I will still be 'working' a little.

As I said on Sunday, much as I appreciate your thanks, I should be thanking all of you; I have been very blessed by being able to work with you all and building friendships.

About 8 years ago I was asked by the Rev'd Matthew Jackson, Rural Dean, if I would meet Christina Mason who had found herself as the only priest leading a group of 5 parishes. I had been retired from a 20+ year old full-time ministry for nearly 3 years by then and was happy helping out in Attleborough and the wider Deanery when necessary. I agreed to meet her to see if I could advise and support on a way forward.

On meeting Christina I was presented with what seemed to be a lively Benefice but she outlined a variety of difficulties. Somehow, I felt a great urge, a shove in the back (probably from God), to offer my help and, encouraged by my husband, eventually stepped into the role in which you have known me ever since. It was not an easy decision as we had a few personal issues with which to deal at the time, but our family was very supportive.

The rest is history, as they say. We are now a united Benefice with a culture of listening to each other and cooperation, the latter sometimes reluctantly, but we have made it work. In addition I am gratified to see some individuals creating ideas for worship as well as those leading their parishes in every way required by the Diocese, but mainly by God.

You are now to move on to the next stage feeling, I hope, confident in what you are doing. Tori is one of the best. She has a huge task in front of her. I intend to stay in the background, encouraging and supporting as she brings the two Benefices into one. She has already had to deal with a couple of crises (not in Shellrock!), and I am sure you will give her your loyalty and love, as you have given it to me.

Which brings me full circle. Thankyou for the love, thankyou for the experience of being with you and allowing me to stay with you throughout these 8 years. You have taught me a great deal, I hope I have been able to bring you a little closer to God. As you have blessed me, I now bless you, and wish some good years ahead for each and every one of you.
